Principal Duties and Responsibilities (Essential Functions):

Essential functions are fundamental job duties. They do not include marginal tasks which are also performed but are incidental to the primary functions. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position, nor does every position allocated to the class necessarily perform every duty listed. Personal characteristics required of all employees such as honesty, industry, sobriety and the ability to get along with others, are presumed qualities and may not be listed specifically.

- Inspects bus and checks gas, oil, water, lights, brakes and steering before driving and may perform minor maintenance work;
- Operates vehicle defensively over assigned route according to a definite schedule;
- Regulates heating and ventilation equipment provided for comfort to passengers;
- Picks up and discharges passengers at designated stops according to schedule and operates flag to stop traffic;
- Instructs passengers in safety precautions when boarding and departing;
- Signals passengers when to cross street or highway and waits to see them safely across;
- Operates vehicle in compliance with all traffic safety laws and regulations, including defensive driving habits and posted speed limits;
- Maintains order among passengers and reports cases of misbehavior to proper officials;
- Reports accidents immediately to Highway Patrol and school officials;
- Reports prolonged traffic delays or any unusual happenings;
- Prepares reports of bus mileage, gas, oil consumption and number of passengers transported and keeps bus clean and orderly;
- Arranges for necessary repairs and maintenance work;
- Prepares reports of activities;
- Performs related duties as required.
